Ever wonder what goes on during an OSOM weekend? Although the experiences are as unique as each student, a typical Friday and Saturday might look a little like this:



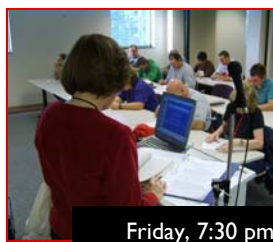
Friday, 6:30 pm

Check-in, pick up name badge, turn in photocopy of completed text overview.



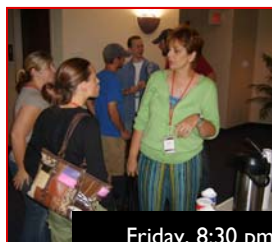
Friday, 7:00 pm

Class is over for the night. Time to relax, study, pray, or ... just hit the hay.



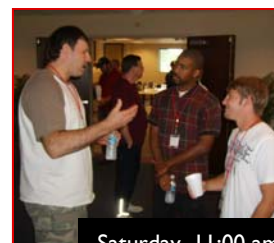
Saturday, 9:00 am
